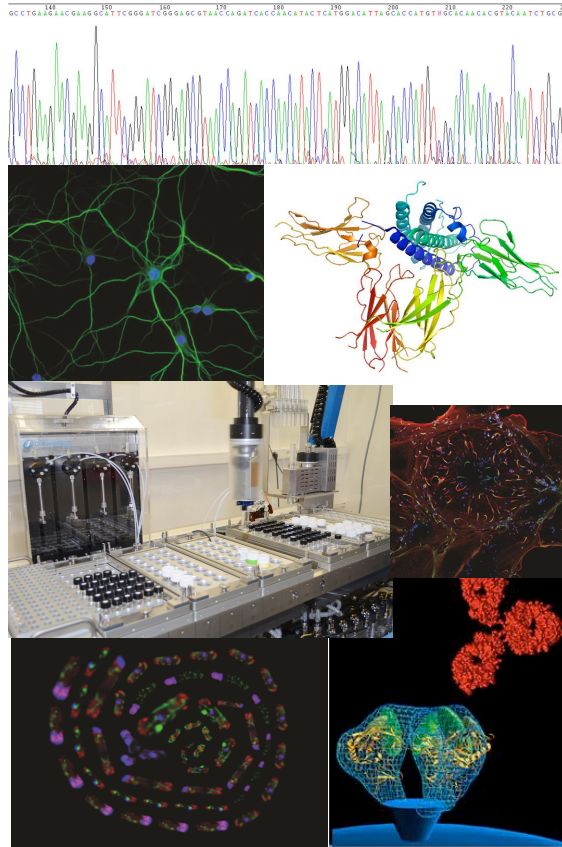


WHAT IS CTLS ?

CTLS (acronym for Core Technologies for Life Science) is the basis for a new European society to promote science and teaching within Core Facilities. The rapid advances in technologies and the changes in funding are pushing lead Universities and Research Institutes to regroup advanced technologies into core facilities enabling high-level research to have access to high-tech equipment without being restricted by budget cuts and obsolete equipment.
